


## **UTE STAMPEDE OUEEN'S CONTEST RULES**

- 1. The contestants must be between the ages of 16 and 24 as of July 1, 2025.
- 2. Contestants shall never have been married.
- 3. Contestants shall not have been a previous Queen of the Ute Stampede.
- 4. Contestants shall waiveliability.
- 5. Contestants shall remain singleduring their reign. In the event Contestant might marry Contestant will resign in which case the first attendant will succeed the Queen as the case may warrant.
- 6. Contestants will conduct themselves in a manner befitting the titleof Ute Stampede Royalty.
- 7. Contestants shall follow the direction of the Ute StampedeCommittee or its representative.
- 8. Contestants shall appearpublicly as Ute Stampede Royalty only with approval of the Ute Stampede Committee.
- 9. Contestants must agree to attendand support all sanctioned publicappearances in full Western Attire.
- 10. Contestants will not be free to plan their own schedule but must follow the schedule set up by the Ute Stampede Committee and attendall scheduled appearances.
- 11. The contestants willbe judged on three different categories. They are Personality, Appearance and Horsemanship. Each categorywill be judged separately.
- 12. The Ute StampedeCommittee will make all decisions concerning eligibility, the contest, the conduct and the scheduleof royalty.
- 13. Any contestants selected to reign as Ute Stampede Royaltyand who is also selected to reign in any other celebration royalty shall forfeitheir right as a member of the Ute Stampede Royalty.

## RIDING PATTERN

- 1. Enter the arena through the south gate and then mount your horse.
- 2. Starting on either lead, lope to the center of the arena, facing north, then complete a slide stop.
- 3. Complete two spins to the right.
- 4. Complete two and a fourth spin to the left.
- 5. Starting on the right lead, complete a small slow circle.
- 6. Switch leads in the center and complete a small slow circle to the left.
- 7. Complete a large fast circle to the right, then a large fast circle to the left.
- 8. Trot facing the grandstands, then start on the left lead to complete a roll back, staying twenty feet from the fence.
- 9. Start on right lead to the opposite side of arena, staying twenty feet from the fence.
- 10. Stop past the center marker, then back to the center marker.
- 11. Walk towards judges then complete a presentation ride.
- 12. Dismount horse and exit the arena from the east gate.
